SCHOOL DRESS CODE

REASONS FOR HAVING A SCHOOL DRESS CODE:

- Neat school dress encourages children to take pride in their appearance and reflects the efforts of teachers to encourage children to take pride in the neatness and presentation of their work
- Wearing school dress mirrors the expectation of society that we dress appropriately for our occupations
- Enhances student feeling of 'belonging' to the group
- Reduces the pressure for the wearing of 'fad' clothing which can create negative rivalry and competition
- Resolves the issue of 'what to wear'
- Enhances identification/safety aspect in school and on excursions
- Students can take pride in their appearance as an identifiable group when in public
- Presents a positive image for the school

WHAT CAN BE WORN

School Uniform

- Royal Blue school shirt with Miling PS Logo
- White school shirt with Miling PS Logo (to be worn on Assembly days, excursions and any other significant day)
- Royal Blue shorts, skirt or skorts (please ensure skirts are appropriate length)
- Royal Blue track pants
- Royal Blue school jumper with Miling PS logo /plain with no logo
- Royal Blue and white school jacket
- Tights/Leggings/skivvies/long sleeve shirts (blue or white only)
- Royal Blue school hat – either wide-brimmed or bucket (wide-brimmed hats will be required to be worn to special whole school events in 2018 where students are representing Miling Primary School such as, but not limited to, excursions and sports carnivals.

Footwear

- Sneakers, shoes, sandals (with ankle straps)
- Appropriate footwear for sport and physical education

FOR SAFETY REASONS AND IN KEEPING WITH A POSITIVE IMAGE, CHILDREN SHOULD NOT BE WEARING THE FOLLOWING TO SCHOOL

- Jewellery such as necklaces, bracelets and dangling earrings (studs, small earrings or sleepers allowed)
- Tattoos of any kind on the skin
- Nail polish
- Long hair should be tied up neatly
